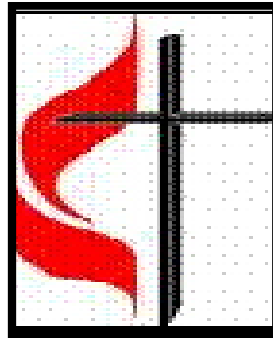

From The Pastor's Study

Our Summer Food Program – a Shared Blessing!

Some Statistics: Through the end of June we have served 60 different families in our immediate neighborhood. The average number of families per week is 45-50. The June totals revealed that from those 60 households we served 204 children and 136 adults!

To put that another way, we have given out almost 1,000 pounds of rice and almost 800 cans of fruit – plus all the other things folks get each week.

Our church garden has offered up green beans and cucumbers for the last two weeks – and the tomatoes on our 55 plants are almost ripe!

Financially this program is in good shape.

We began the season with a reserve of \$1223. Contributions of \$3,099 were taken in from our members, CrieveWood UMC and a few others. In kind canned fruit donations of 782 cans (approximate value \$800) have come from Mt. Pisgah UMC, Forrest Hills UMC and from five of our families!



Through June we have purchased \$1795 worth of food from Second Harvest Food Bank (rice, dried beans, canned veggies, shelf stable milk, cereal, frozen chicken, some fresh milk and dozens of fresh eggs!)

Volunteers: A host of people from our church and from Mt Pisgah have been working together each week – in the garden, transporting food from Second Harvest, and helping to greet the families and distribute food. A full list will follow at the end of the program.

Thanks to all who have contributed in so many ways to this important ministry.

Thanks to all who have contributed and made possible the Habitat BBQ and Music fundraiser of June 25; as well as those who have made our Tuesday mornings at Haywood Lane apartments possible and have been part of the summer Wednesday afternoon Programs. Also, to all who covered these ministries with prayer.

May we continue to give and receive blessings as we work together and as we are blessed by those we seek to serve – all in the name of Christ! Ann Cover
