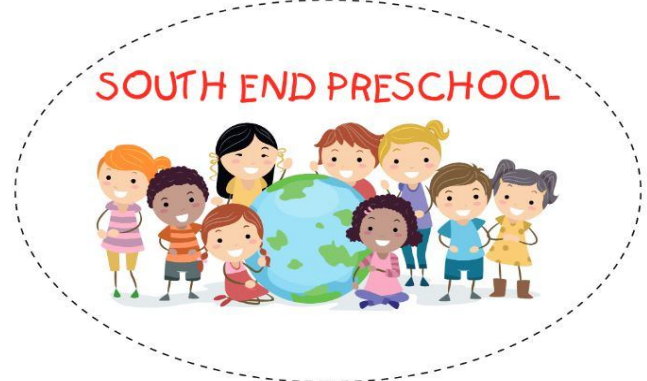


Our Easter Sunday offering for UMCOR was \$424.00. Thanks to each of you who gave.

**April 2019**

Total donations were \$1,736, and distributions were \$2,563 with surplus from the previous month. This was given to 11 families for assistance with gas, rent, food, utilities and medicine.
