From The Pastor's Study

Our Summer Food Program 2019 – Year Seven

Overview:
Sixty- seven different families participated in the program. Small sized households comprised 12% of these families. Sixty-nine percent are households numbered 4-6 people and 19% of the families included 7 - 11 people.

The **total number** of people impacted by this ministry is **345 (children and adults)**. The number of families served per week averaged in at 25. These families live in our immediate neighborhood and were directed to us by Tusculum, Norman Binkley and Haywood Elementary Schools.



Weekly we offered food to families in amounts based on size of the household. For example, a medium sized family (4-6 people in the household) received 6 lbs. of rice, 5 lbs. of dried beans, 4 cans of fruit, 4 cans of vegetables, 2 qtrs. shelf stable milk and frozen chicken.

Depending on the availability of food from our church garden, families are also offered fresh green beans, tomatoes, hot peppers, and cucumbers.

Sources of Funding:
South End UMC budget, gifts of canned fruit from individual families and a gift of \$300 from Forest Hills United Methodist Church.

Foods Totals and Costs:
We **purchased a total of almost 4,272 pounds** of food from Second Harvest Food Bank (rice, dried beans, canned vegetables and shelf stable milk) at a **cost of \$2,171**. We received **1,422 pounds of frozen chicken and 240 pounds of fresh milk and yogurt at no cost to the church** over the course of the summer. Thus **in total we received 5,934 pounds of food from Second Harvest Food Bank** to distribute to our neighbors.



In addition, approximately **\$1,200 worth of canned fruit** (1095 cans of peaches, mandarin oranges and pineapple) were purchased at Aldi's and Kroger, donated and delivered to the church by twelve SEUMC church families.

In the next newsletter I will list all of the volunteers, as I confirm all of the lists!

For now, I wish to thank all who contributed time and energy and resources, work in the garden, help with transport and unloading of food, planning and recruiting and all those prayers lifted up for this ministry!

I pray that this ministry of bringing a healthy supplement of food to families in our neighborhood has been as much an experience of grace to those who received food as it has been for those who made possible the giving of this food!
